Business Casual

- More patterns and colors are acceptable
- Collared shirt or blouse
- Nice pants or fingertip length skirt
- Tie optional
- Dress shoes
- Jacket or cardigan can be added

Accessories

- **Jewelry:** Keep it simple. Small and neutral colors. Not Distracting
- **Scarves:** Tie a simple knot. Don't wear a winter scarf.
- **Purse/Briefcase:** Neutral colors. Best to match with your shoes. Have one of a practical size.
- **Watch:** Adds professional elegance to any look.
- **Belt:** Simple and does the job.
- **Tie:** The finishing touch to any suit is a tie.
- **Lint roller:** It is useful to have a lint roller on hand to make sure you're always looking as sharp as possible.
